Introduction

At the outset, Dr. D.K. Agarwal, Member-Secretary and Registrar-General, PPVFR Authority welcomed all the members present. The Members also gave a warm welcome to Dr. T. Mohapatra, Chairperson, PPVFR Authority. Members stated that Authority will reach new heights under his chairmanship. In his introductory remarks, the Chairperson also welcomed the members. He stated that the main purpose of the Authority is registration of varieties. In the past 18 years, guidelines have been framed for around 190 crop species which is in itself a big achievement. He also acknowledged the continuous support by the Nodal Ministry in implementing the Act. He thanked ICAR for the support in framing of DUS test guidelines and in conducting DUS testing and assisting Authority in implementation of PPVFR Act, 2001. He stated that PPVFR Authority had organized two interface meetings one with ICAR and other one with NBA and both were of extreme importance and would pave the way towards greater synergy between these institutions. He briefly described some targets for future. Dr. Mohapatra, then requested Dr. D.K. Agarwal, Member-Secretary/ Registrar-General, PPVFR Authority to make a detailed presentation of the Agenda of 36th Meeting of PPVFR Authority.
