ORDER

Heard the parties.

The Opponent had filed the Final Opposition with a delay of 3 days and Evidence with a delay of one day respectively. The Opponent ought to have filed the Final Opposition by 23rd August, 2019 and Evidence by 24th August, 2019 which is one month and 30 days



respectively from the date of receipt of PV-33 documents on 24th July, 2019. This was as per the previous order dated 3rd August, 2019 of this Registry passed in the instant matter. The Opponent dispatched the Final Opposition and Evidence on 26th August, 2019 which was received on 27th August, 2019. Further 24th August, 2019 and 25th August, 2019 were Saturday and Sunday respectively.

Counsel for Opponent stated that they had filed PV-5 for 3 months and they have requested for three months but Registrar has passed the order dated 3rd August, 2019 granting only the time as provided in the Rules.

The Counsel for Applicant fairly agreed to allow the PV-5 provided the proceedings should not be delayed any further.

I perused the relevant documents and the order dated 3rd August, 2019 of this Registry in this matter. The said order was passed after hearing both the parties namely Opponent and Applicant. The Opponent should not be prejudiced due to a minor delay and at the same time proceedings should also not be get delayed.

Accordingly, in the interest of justice and to expedite the proceedings, I hereby direct the Opponent to file PV-5 with fees of Rs.10,000/- for Final Opposition and Evidence along with costs of Rs.6000/- to be deposited to National Gene Fund for taking on record the final opposition and evidence. Payment details enclosed. The Opponent has to pay in total Rs.16,000/-



The same has to be done on or before 12th March, 2026.
No further time extension will be granted in this regard.

Heard the Opponent and Applicant finally.

The matter is posted for final hearing for rejoinder arguments of the Opponent on 13th March, 2026 at 04:30 PM.
